Dear Dr. Langlois:

I approve your recent request to decrease the number of semester credit hours (SCH) for the following degree programs:

DPHR in Pharmacy (CIP 51.2001.00) reduced from 213 SCH to 153 SCH.

This decrease in SCH will align the DPHR program with other PharmD programs in the state, adjust the program inventory to reflect only the SCHs for coursework in the professional program, and reflect recent revisions to the professional program's curriculum which increase SCHs from 147 SCH to 153 SCH.

These actions are taken according to the Coordinating Board Rules, Chapter 5, Subchapter C, Section 5.55 – Revisions to Approved Programs.
