**FUNCTION:** To study problems in this area of concern; to advise on such problems or issues referred to it by any member of the faculty, the provost, the president, the chancellor, or the Board of Regents.

**COMPOSITION:** Seven members chosen at large from and by the voting members of the General Faculty for three-year staggered terms. In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. Deans, associate deans, assistant deans, department chairs, and other administrative officials are ineligible for election or appointment. The committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The committee shall always contain a faculty member from the Law School by election or, if no Law School faculty member is elected, by appointment.

### A-3 Faculty Committee on Committees

FUNCTION: To advise with the president on personnel for standing committees of the General Faculty and the uses to be made of the committee system; to make recommendations to the Faculty Council regarding changes composition, functions, and responsibilities of standing committees, including term limits and voting rights of committee members.

COMPOSITION: Nine voting members of the General Faculty for three-year staggered terms. Two of them shall be appointed annually from a panel of four faculty members elected at large from and by the voting members of the General Faculty through the Hare-Clark preferential voting system and one appointed annually by the president through the regular procedures of the Committee on Committees. In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. Each year, the Committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The Secretary of the General Faculty (*ex officio*) and the chair elect of the Faculty Council (non-voting *ex officio*) shall also be members of the committee. No member, except the Secretary of the General Faculty, may serve continuously for more than six years.

#### A-4 Faculty Grievance Committee

**FUNCTION:** The Faculty Grievance Committee is authorized to hear or otherwise dispose of individual grievances. Faculty grievance procedures are set forth in HOP 2-2310 of the UT Austin Handbook of Operating Procedures.

**COMPOSITION:** Sixteen voting members of the General Faculty, for three-year staggered terms. Ten members are elected at large by the General Faculty and six members are appointed by the president through the regular procedures of the Committee on Committees. In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. The total committee membership shall not include more than four faculty members from any college or school. Each year, the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The vice chair shall assume the role of chair the following year; the Past chair shall serve as an *ex officio*, voting member of the committee. ### A-6 General Faculty Rules and Governance Committee

**FUNCTION:** To propose changes in the rules of procedure and governance structure of the General Faculty and the Faculty Council; to propose changes to the general voting rights of the General Faculty; to study all other proposed changes in and additions to the rules of procedure of the General Faculty and the Faculty Council; and to submit recommendations to the Faculty Council. If the recommendations concern the Faculty Council, the Committee will report also to the president, as the head of the General Faculty. In addition, this committee's function is to make the final ruling in any election dispute or on any election matter not covered by the rules; to handle questions of interpretation of rules; and to determine questions of jurisdiction arising between the Faculty Council and the General Faculty.

**COMPOSITION:** Three members elected at large from and by the voting members of the General Faculty, for three-year staggered terms. The secretary of the General Faculty and the chair of the Faculty Council shall serve as voting members, and each year, the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. Each year, the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee.

In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. Each year, the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The director of Student Financial Services, a representative of the Dean of Students, and a representative from the Office of Graduate Studies shall serve as administrative advisers without vote. The president may appoint additional non-voting administrative advisors from the general administration areas of the university.

## B-2 Recreational Sports Committee

**FUNCTION:** To determine policy for the conduct of the intramural programs; to approve and authorize publication of all rules and regulations governing intramural sports; to hear appeals of decisions of the Intramural Sports Council; and to promulgate regulations designating the faculty and staff members and other persons who are entitled to participate in the faculty and staff competitive and recreational programs.

**COMPOSITION:** Thirteen members appointed by the president, including six voting members of the General Faculty for three-year staggered terms; two members of the University staff for two-year staggered terms; two students, a male and a female, designated by the Councils of Recreational Sports; two other students, a male and a female, designated by Student Government; and one member of the University staff designated by the non-student program and appointed to serve as a member without vote for a one-year term. In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. Each year, the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The Director of Recreational Sports shall serve as an administrative advisor without vote.

Two student athlete members, one each from men's and women's athletics, will be appointed by the president from a list submitted by the Student Athletes Advisory Council. In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. The Faculty Athletics Representative (FAR) shall serve on the committee in an advisory capacity. Each year, the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair, who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The faculty-appointed representative to the Coalition on Intercollegiate Athletics (COIA) will be invited to serve as an ex-officio member.

**C-5 Faculty Building Advisory Committee**

**FUNCTION:** To represent the faculty, staff, and students in the planning and programming of buildings. The committee shall have a strong voice in (a) campus master planning, (b) priority of building construction, (c) building location, (d) programming of buildings, and (e) reviewing and recommending of final plans. It shall report to the president and periodically to the Faculty Council. During the preparation of the preliminary plans for the erection of a particular building, the president shall appoint a special committee, composed of faculty (and students, when appropriate) who have a direct interest in the proposed building, to serve until the completion thereof, one of whom shall be designated as a voting member of the Faculty Building Advisory Committee for the specified building. Whenever a building is to include library facilities, the University librarian is to be added as an administrative advisor to the special committee.

**COMPOSITION:** Nine voting members of the General Faculty, including a representative from the School of Architecture, and one member of the University staff, all appointed by the president for five-year terms. Two undergraduate students appointed by the president from a panel of names submitted by Student Government, and one graduate student from a panel submitted by the Graduate Student Assembly. Students shall serve one-year terms and shall be eligible for reappointment. The students may not be from the same college or school. In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. Each year, the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The vice president for University Operations or a delegate shall be an *ex officio* member. The UT System associate vice chancellor for Facilities Planning and Construction and a representative from the Office of Campus Planning and Facilities Management shall serve as administrative advisors without vote.

**C-13 Information Technology Committee**

**FUNCTION:** To recommend to the president, and to the vice -president for information technology, and to the Faculty Council changes in policies regarding information technology; to consult with and advise the chief information officer about policies and procedures pertaining to information technology at the University.

**COMPOSITION:** Fifteen voting members of the General Faculty, thirteen of which will serve three-year staggered terms. In addition, every year the chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint two voting faculty members of the Faculty Council for one-year terms. Eight of the faculty members will be from college/school faculty information technology (IT) committees and will rotate among the colleges and schools that have

faculty IT committees. As an IT faculty term expires, the deans of colleges/schools with faculty IT committees will send the name of a faculty member of the IT committee to the Committee on Committees. The remaining five faculty members will be selected through the regular procedures of the Committee on Committees (see HOP 2-1040 section B). The Committee on Committees will submit all faculty recommendations/nominations, including the IT panel, to the president for appointment. There will be four staff members appointed for two-year staggered terms. At least two of the staff member representatives shall not be employed in IT-related areas. The president shall appoint three student members for one-year terms, one from each panel of names submitted by Student Government, the Senate of College Councils, and the Graduate Student Assembly. Each year, the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair who shall be voting faculty members of the committee. The Chief Information Officer and a representative from the Information Technology Research & Educational Technology Committee (R&E) shall serve as *ex officio* members without vote. A representative from each of the following shall be selected by the president to serve as an administrative advisor without vote: the Center for Teaching and Learning, financial affairs, and department chairs.

#### **C-14 Technology-Enhanced Education Oversight Committee<sup>11</sup>**

**FUNCTION:** To evaluate and formulate policy on technology-enhanced education and make recommendations on such matters to the Faculty Council and to the University's Steering and Strategic Policy Committees<sup>1</sup> on Technology-Enhanced Education. To ensure that initiatives in technology-enhanced education further the University's mission to be a university of the first rank by reviewing the following:

- programmatic proposals;
- technology-enhanced courses and curricula offered by the University and certificates and degrees associated with such
- academic quality of other on-line resources
- use of on-line materials for credit toward University degrees (including transfer credits and dual credits)
- overall impact of such offerings on workload, intellectual property, and promotion/tenure issues for faculty and instructional staff
- student issues, such as privacy

**COMPOSITION:** Five voting members of the General Faculty for three-year staggered terms appointed by the president through the regular procedures of the Committee on Committees, two staff members for two-year staggered terms from college or departmental student development/advising staff (and each from different colleges/schools), and three student members. The president shall appoint one from a panel of names submitted by the Senate of College Councils, one from a panel of names submitted by Student Government, and one from a panel of names submitted by the Graduate Student Assembly. The Graduate Student Assembly panel shall include at least one graduate student who is or has served as an assistant instructor or teaching assistant in an undergraduate course at the University (and all those on the list who meet this criterion shall be indicated). The students shall be from different colleges or schools. Each year the chair of Faculty Council shall appoint two voting members of Faculty Council for one-year terms. One of these faculty members should be from the C4-Educational Policy Committee and one from the Faculty Council Executive Committee.<sup>2</sup> Each year the chair of the Graduate Assembly shall appoint one voting member from the Academic Committee of the Graduate Assembly for a one-year term. Each year the committee shall elect its own chair and vice chair from among the voting faculty members of the committee. Two members of the provost's senior staff shall serve as ex-officio members without vote. They should include the vice provost for higher education policy and the chair of the Steering Committee on Technology-Enhanced Education.<sup>3</sup> The president will appoint three representatives from the following list to serve as administrative advisors without vote (only one representative per category):
