Standing Committee C-6: International Programs and Studies Committee

Convening, Participation, and Prior Outcomes

The Chair convened the meeting of The University of Texas at Austin's (UT) Faculty Council's (FC) International Programs and Studies Committee (hereafter the C-6 Committee) around 1:15 PM on November 14, 2016. In attendance were four C-6 Committee members (in alphabetical order): Ryan Alexander (student representative); David Eaton (LBJ School); Alexandra Garcia (Nursing); Melissa Murphy (Spanish and Portuguese); and Jonathan Sessler (Chemistry). Also in attendance (in alphabetical order) were Maria Arrellaga, Executive Director of Global Engagement, Office of the UT President; Marvin Hackert, Interim Dean, Graduate School (Molecular Biosciences) and Heather Thompson, Director, UT Study Abroad.

Agenda Items, November 14, 2016

Item 1: How to Support UT International Engagement - Study Abroad Office

The C-6 Committee discussed how to assist the Study Abroad Office in its efforts to increase UT student participation in semester-long international programs abroad managed by local universities, where the content has been pre-approved by UT departments for undergraduate academic credit. In its October meeting, the C-6 Committee decided to try to collect three types of databases that could be used to develop a so-called "Campus (UT) Ambassador" program. Current students who have traveled abroad in such semester-long programs would be matched with an appropriate-discipline classroom to tell of her/his experience. UT staff volunteered to try and collect information on any current UT undergraduates who have studied abroad in such semester-long pre-approved programs. Those students could be asked whether they would be willing to visit a classroom to discuss their international program experiences. Heather Thompson indicated that she has a data base of undergraduates who could be invited to become a Campus Ambassador. The C-6 Committee Chair has collected two other types of data: (a) a list of all UT department chairs or equivalent and (b) a list of all UT undergraduate academic advisors and program coordinators. The Graduate School provided the database of department chairs. Ms. Kayla Ford of the Red McCombs School of Business has provided a list of undergraduate academic advisors and program coordinators. The C-6 Committee agreed that in its December, 2016 it will consider whether to "pilot" a Campus Ambassador concept in a few departments. For consideration at the C-6 Committee in December, 2016, the C-6 Committee Chair has drafted correspondence to UT Department Chairs as well as students who could serve as a Campus Ambassador

Item 2: How to Support UT International Engagement – UT President's Office

A brief discussion was held about the UT President's Office's (UTPO) efforts to expand international engagement. The C-6 Committee Chair provided draft information to the UTPO on (a) UT websites with international program information and (b) a draft format for a UT survey of international affiliations. The C-6 Chair in the December 2016 C-6 meeting will provide as illustrations a more complete set of survey responses from the LBJ School and IC². The next steps in collecting information will be up to the UTPO.

Item 3: Insurance Programs for Faculty Leading Study Program Abroad

Heather Thompson discussed efforts to collect information on insurance policies for use by for faculty members considering taking students abroad. These policies are offered by the UT System and UT Austin for risk prevention and risk mitigation for international programs and studies. The C-6 Committee discussed: the types of information about each insurance policy that would be useful; the format for a report or other communication about insurance options; and how to distribute such information for faculty considering programs abroad. The C-6 Committee seeks to complete such a report on insurance policies during the 2016-17 academic year and to make it available for faculty considering programs abroad.

Item 4: Faculty Responsibilities for Student Welfare While in International Programs

The C-6 Committee confirmed that in the December 2016 meeting it will discuss faculty responsibilities for student welfare while participating in UT-sanctioned study, research or service abroad. Such information on faculty responsibilities for student welfare would inform faculty members considering taking students abroad. At the December 5 meeting the C-6 Committee will discuss: the types of information about each faculty responsibility that would be useful; the format for a report or other communication about faculty responsibilities for students while participating in study, research or service abroad; and how to distribute such information for faculty considering programs abroad. During the 2016-17 academic year the C-6 Committee seeks to complete such a report on faculty responsibilities for student welfare while in international programs and make it available for faculty considering programs abroad.

Item 5: Other New Business

Professor Sessler proposed new business for the C-6 Committee and he will provide details in writing for the December 2016 C-6 meeting.
