#### ORGAN OR HARPSICHORD PERFORMANCE MAJOR

## **Major Requirements**

- 1. Performance <u>and pedagogy</u>: Twenty eight <u>Thirty</u> semester hours, consisting of four semesters of major instrument course 312, two semesters of major instrument course 362, Music 420R, 460R, <u>275T</u>, and 222J or 223J
- 2. Music literature and music theory: Music 605, 411, 612, 312C, 213M, 213N, 321J, 325L, 325M, 226J, 230L, and three semester hours chosen from Music 331J, 334, 337, 342, 343J, and 379K
- 3. Music ensemble: Two semesters of Music 259N and eight semester hours of music ensemble courses as explained in Butler School of Music Special Requirements

When taken in residence, Music 312C may also be counted toward the three-semester-hour writing flag portion of the core curriculum English composition requirement. Music 334 which may be used to complete requirement 2 is also approved to fulfill the visual and performing arts requirement of the core curriculum and may be used to fulfill both.

## **Electives**

Four Two semester hours chosen from courses either within or outside the Butler School of Music. Additional elective coursework may be needed to provide the total number of semester hours required for the degree.

# **Total Minimum Requirements**

For the BMusic with a major in organ or harpsichord performance: 120 semester hours as outlined above.
