### **Health Promotion and Behavioral Science**

Health promotion and behavioral science majors must complete the following:

3. Either a specialization in the Department of Kinesiology and Health Education, a minor outside

the department, a certificate, or a track in a second field of study which consist of a minimum of 15 hours of coursework, six of which must be upper-division. No more than six hours in the minor may also be counted toward other degree requirements.
