## **Physical Culture and Sports**

Physical culture and sports majors must complete the following:

- 2. 18 21 semester hours in the cognate in physical culture and sports:
  - a. Kinesiology 349
  - b. Six semester hours chosen from <u>Kinesiology 311K</u>, <u>KIN 312 Topic 4 Philosophy & Leadership in Sport and Physical Activity</u>, <u>348</u>, <u>KIN 350</u>, <u>KIN 352K Topic 5 Sport</u>, <u>Fitness</u>, <u>and Mass Media</u>, <u>KIN 352K Topic 6 Race & Sport in African-American Life</u>, <u>KIN 355</u>, <u>and 361</u>, <u>KIN 362</u>, and <u>KIN 363</u>.
  - c. 3 hours from <u>Kinesiology 350</u> or <u>KIN 352K Topic 6 Race & Sport in African-American Life</u>, whichever is not used in 2b.
  - d. Kinesiology 351
  - e. An additional upper-division course in kinesiology or health education.
  - e. KIN 352K Historical Trends/Current Issues in American Physical Culture
  - f. Three semester hours of a kinesiology or health education elective.
- 3. Either a specialization in the Department of Kinesiology and Health Education, a minor outside the department, a certificate, or a track in a second field of study which consist of a minimum of 15 hours of coursework, six of which must be upper-division. No more than six hours in the minor may also be counted toward other degree requirements. Information about approved areas of study and specific courses that may be used is available in the Student Dean's Office, George I. Sánchez Building 216 and in the Kinesiology Advising Center, Bellmont Hall 1005.
