Study examines the social cognitive and social communication development of infants 24 months and under with an older sibling diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder (ASD) compared to infants without an older sibling with an ASD.

Duties: Vary according to experience. Examples include: recruiting and scheduling participants, behavioral coding of video taped assessments of infant development, data entry, scoring assessments, setting up for appointments, video recording, etc. Attending a weekly lab meeting is required.
