







ProTools – Creating a Click Track

	<p>Go to Track&gt;Create Click Track</p>
	<p>Track will show up in Edit and Mix Window and will be titled Click 1</p>
	<p>In the Transport window make sure the Metronome Icon is highlighted blue</p>
	<p>The Metronome Icon is in the Midi Controls section of the Transport tool Window</p>
	<p>If you don't see it click on the downturned arrow and make sure it is checked.</p>
