

## POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Graduate Assistant for Living Learning Communities (LLCs) & Academic Initiatives position in Residence Life is responsible for supporting the Manager for Living Learning Communities and Academic Initiatives. This person will be primarily responsible for assisting with the development and programming of various LLCs as well as other academic initiatives offered through Residence Life. This person will interface frequently with departments and stakeholders across campus that work with Residence Life through Living Learning Communities. This position may also provide leadership and co-supervision of specific LLCs.

# ROLE BREAKDOWN/ESTIMATED WEEKLY HOURS (20 TOTAL)

- Support and assist the Manager of LLCs and Academic Initiatives with the Living Learning Communities program. Serve as the main point of contact for 1-3 LLCs. - 8 hours
- Create and implement comprehensive assessment plan for the LLC program. - 4 hours
- Support and assist academic initiatives for the residence halls (Faculty Connections, learning center partnerships). - 4 hours
- Serve on departmental/university committees to collaborate on departmental goals/initiatives. 3 hours
- Presenting small-and large-scale programs, activities, and trainings for students and staff. - 1 hour

#### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Applicant must have completed a Bachelor's degree and be accepted into a graduate program at The University of Texas at Austin.

## PREFERRED OUALIFICATIONS

Preference will be given to Master's and Doctoral students in the Department of Educational Leadership and Policy as well as graduate students with experience and/or background in Housing and Residence Life.

### **APPOINTMENT**

This graduate appointment is a \$17.75/hour, 20 hours per week, 9-month assignment starting September 1st – May 31st with an additional summer appointment starting July 11th - Aug. 31st, 2024. Summer appointment is nonbenefits eligible, paid, 40-hours a week assignment. UT Student Academic position insurance benefits package will be included during the academic year. Driving a UT vehicle is considered a marginal task and employees will be asked to complete the driving requirements.

#### **ADDITIONAL BENEFITS**

- On-campus meal plan
- Professional development funds (\$750 per academic year) available to attend a regional or national conference (requires supervisor approval)
- Master's and Doctoral students in the Department of Educational Leadership and Policy may qualify for in-state tuition
- Eligibility for insurance benefits package during the academic year

### **WORK HOURS**

Work a maximum of 20 hours per week as required by all graduates at The University of Texas at Austin. Second year graduate students may work up to 25 hours. Hours to be scheduled between 10 AM and 5 PM, Monday–Friday, with some evening and prescheduled weekend hours.
