Call for Nominations College of Education

Dean's Distinguished Research Award

Purpose:

To recognize a mid-career/senior faculty member in the College of Education who has been on faculty for at least five years and has developed a distinguished record of research/scholarly contributions (the Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Studies can grant exceptions to other research-related professionals who would like to be eligible for this award). Selection will be based on evidence of sustained excellence in research, including such things as publications (quantity and quality), grant activity, and impact and significance of research/scholarship to the field.

Award:

The award recipient will be recognized with a certificate and will receive a stipend of \$2500.

Nomination Procedure:

Nominations are solicited from graduate students and faculty of the college, to be sent to the appropriate department chair by **February 1, 2024**. Each department may nominate one faculty member. Nominations shall include the following:

- a. Nomination letter from the chair (no more than one page)
- b. A curriculum vitae
- c. Research statement that addresses outstanding research/scholarly contributions to one's field, and its impact and significance (no longer than 2 single-spaced pages)

Nomination Deadline:

All nomination materials are to be in the Dean's Office **March 1**, **2024**. Please submit materials as a single PDF to Sonja Runberg at sonja.runberg@austin.utexas.edu.

Selection Procedure:

Final selection will be made by a committee appointed by the Dean and chaired by an Associate Dean. Recipient will be notified of the award in May.
