#### Creation of New Certificate Program: Spanish for Mental Health Professions Certificate

The department would like to create a new certificate program, titled Spanish for Mental Health Professions.

<u>Rationale</u>: This new program is modeled on the current Spanish for Health Care Professions certificate. The new certificate will follow the same program of courses, but will include a new course, SPN 368F (Spanish in Mental Health Contexts) as the final course in the sequence. The Spanish for Health Care Professions certificate has been extremely successful. When we first proposed the certificate several years ago, we anticipated offering one section per year of our Medical Spanish course. We now offer eight sections per year. Our creation of SPN 368F and a certificate program focused on mental health professions responds to robust student demand for courses that specialize in language issues related to the mental health professions.
