The six-year count can include the year of application. The examples do not demonstrate every possibility for the timing of an FDA. For example, some FDAs might start as late as one year later than the application year. And the six-year count is a minimum before FDA eligibility.

Note. A faculty candidate who has already received an FDA must have served as a benefits-eligible faculty member in at least one of the fall and/or spring terms in at least six academic years before the start of their next FDA. The six-year count starts in the year after the successful application year and can include benefits-eligible service in the academic year of application for the next FDA.

The examples do not demonstrate every possibility for the timing of an FDA. For example, some applicants might have some years of service in which they were not benefits-eligible or when they did not work at UT. Those years would delay further when the faculty candidate might be eligible to apply for another FDA. Also, the 2nd FDA might start up to a year after successful application.
