- UT Staff Council Values announced
 - Advocacy
 - Collaboration
 - Transparency
- Guest Speaker Noel Landuyt, Director for the Institute of Organizational Excellence (IOE)
 - Discussed the University-wide data from the <u>Employee</u> <u>Engagement Survey results</u>
 - 44.6% response rate and an overall score of 379
 - Constructs with the lowest scores: Pay, Internal Communication, Employee Development
 - Constructs with the highest scores: Strategic, Supervision, Employee Engagement
- Guest Speaker Mary Knight, Assistant VP of Finance
 - o Discussed <u>UT Austin's Budget for FY 2017-18</u>
 - For FY 17-18 the UT Operating Budget is \$2,975 million dollars with three allocations – academic core, academic enhancement, and self-supporting. Resources making up each allocation were explained
 - Use of funds were explained, with salaries and benefits making up the majority
 - FY 2017-18 to FY 2021-22 Academic Core Projected Budget Forecast was explained
 - Required University-wide budget reductions for this FY are \$10 million. Another \$10 million reduction will be required in FY 2018-19
- New business and announcements:
 - Benefit Concert on Sept 26, 6-10pm in Bates Hall, proceeds go to those affected by Hurricane Harvey
 - Next <u>President's lunch lotto</u> is October 18th. Topic: Campus Climate
 - <u>UT Fall Health Challenge</u> sign up begins Sept 25th. Challenge runs Oct 9th – Nov 5th
