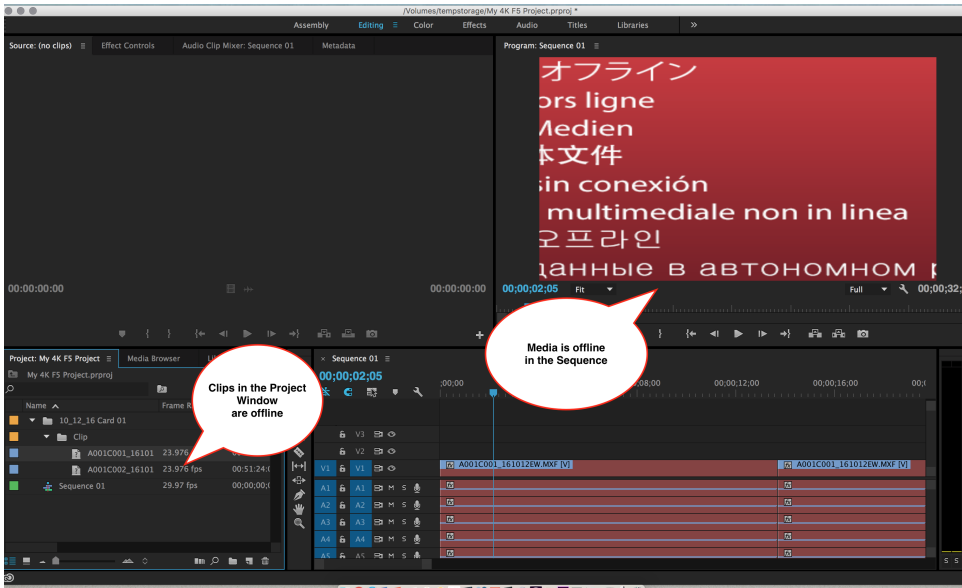


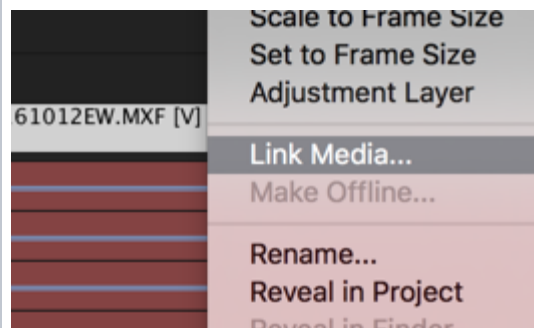
Adobe Premiere Pro - How to Reconnect or Relink Offline Media

This will show you how to fix problems with media that shows as offline

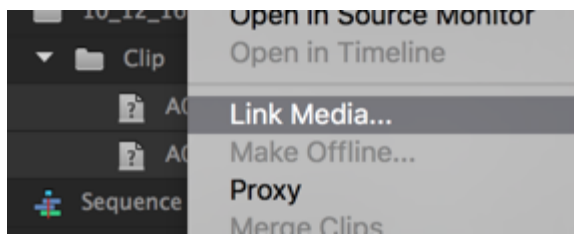

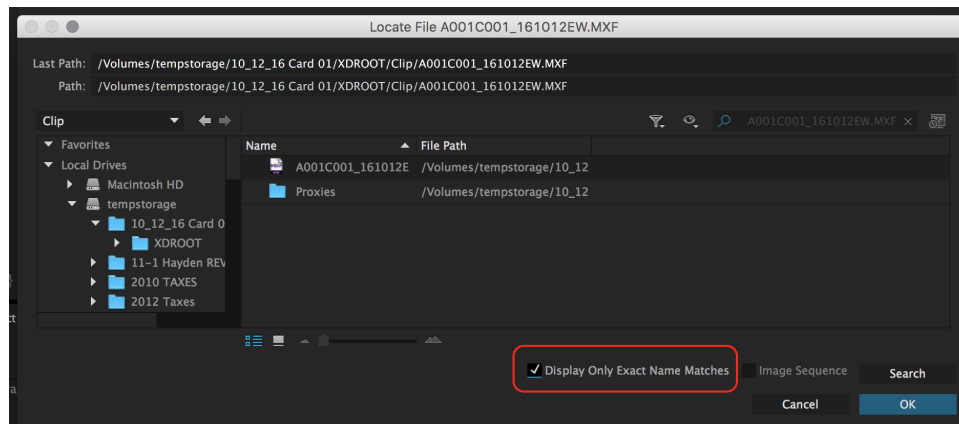
