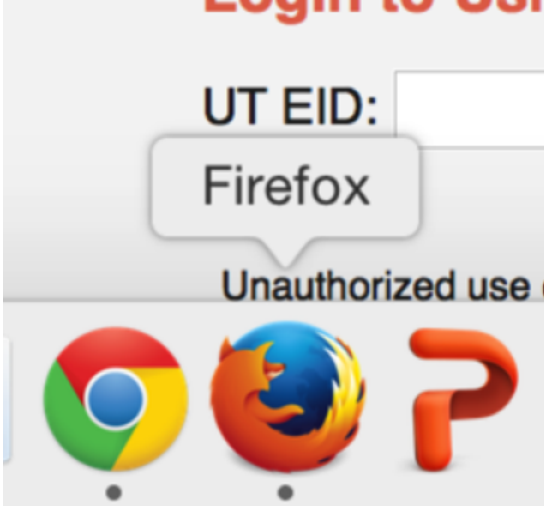


Saving a Web Video from Youtube, Vimeo, etc. Using Video Download Helper and Firefox

Go to Firefox - You have to have the latest version of Firefox installed if you don't then get a proctor or tech staff to update your browser.




Launch it

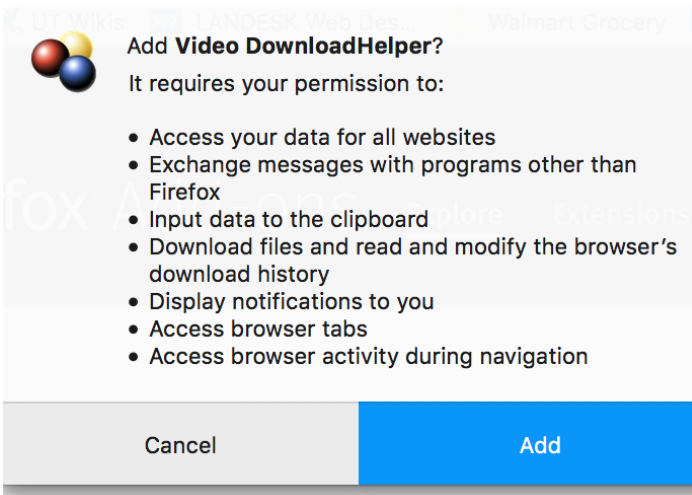

Manage your downloads

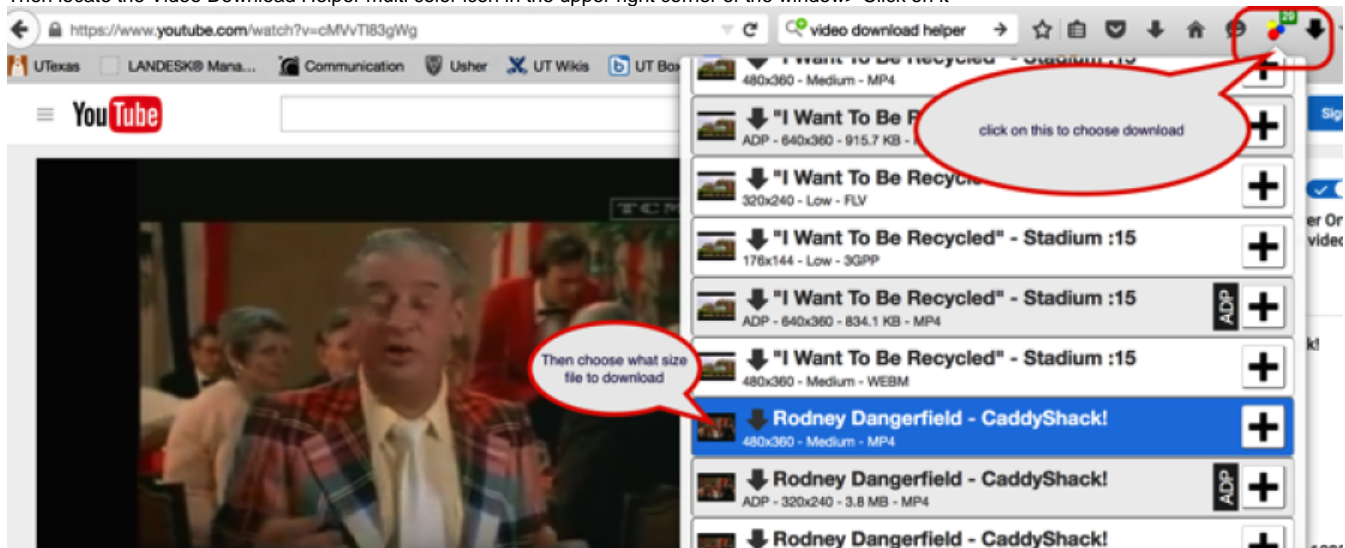
Vidline, a combined Media center and Video clips manager

Then locate the Video Download Helper multi color icon in the upper right corner of the window> Click on it



Choose what size file to download >

You will then get this menu - Choose to "Use browser"



Download method

The actual download can be performed with either the browser or the companion app.

For technical reasons, downloading from the browser services may cause the download to be rejected by the server hosting the video and it is not possible to define an alternative default download folder.

You then get this message anyway - Ignore it you file will be downloaded to your downloads folder.



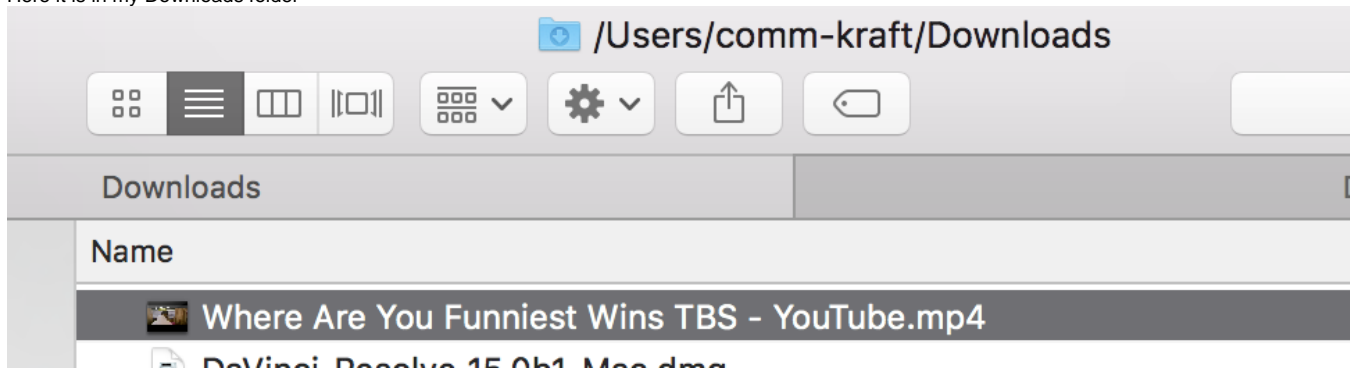
Companion application required
