
## **AVID - Keyframing Audio Volume in AVID**



To add a keyframe put the blue cursor on the timeline where you want to make an audio adjustment and press the apostrophe key (") on the keyboard.

This will add a keyframe. (2 keyframes placed on the timeline will enable you to gradually lower and raise audio) Now just rest the mouse on the keyframe node and move it up or down to adjust audio levels.

Useful shortcuts to navigate your timeline:

- CMD K to shorten track height
   CMD L to increase track height
   CMD [ to zoom out of track

- CMD ] to zoom into track
- CMD / to zoom out to entire track
