






Live Stream a Zoom meeting to YouTube

Set up your Zoom meeting to Live Stream to YouTube

<p>First you will need to enable live streaming in the Zoom settings.</p> <p>Log into your UT Zoom account https://utexas.zoom.us</p> <p>Click on SIGN in to configure your Zoom account</p>	
<p>Sign in with your UT EID</p>	<p>Sign in with your UT EID</p> <p>UT EID</p> <p>Password</p> <p>SIGN IN</p> <p>I forgot my UT EID or password. I need a UT EID. Help</p>
<p>Now that you are logged in to your UT Zoom account,</p> <p>click on SETTINGS, then click on IN MEETING (ADVANCED)</p>	

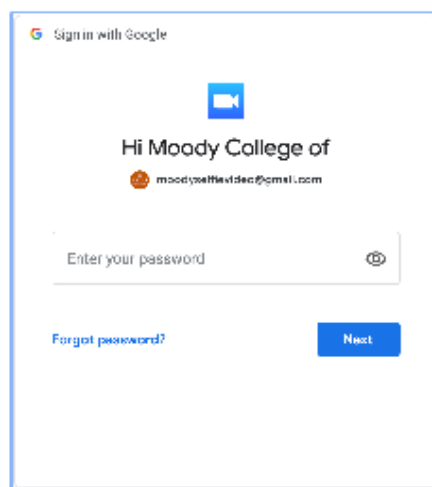
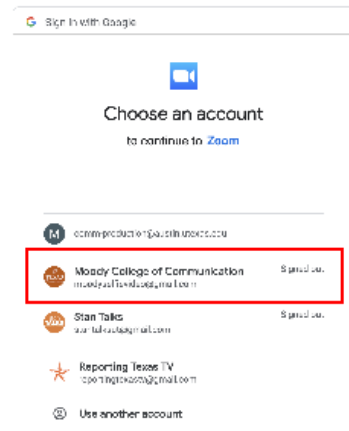

If you do not manage any YouTube accounts you will be asked to add an account.

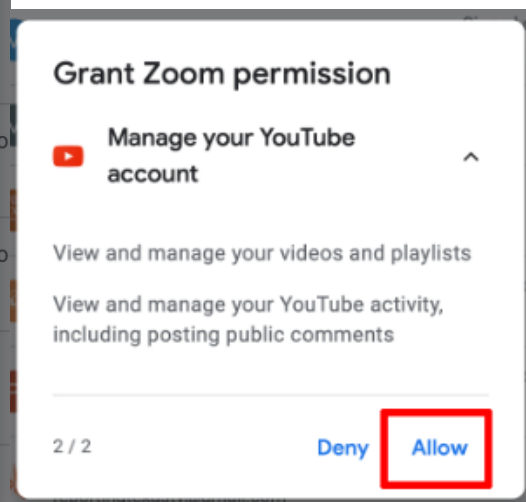
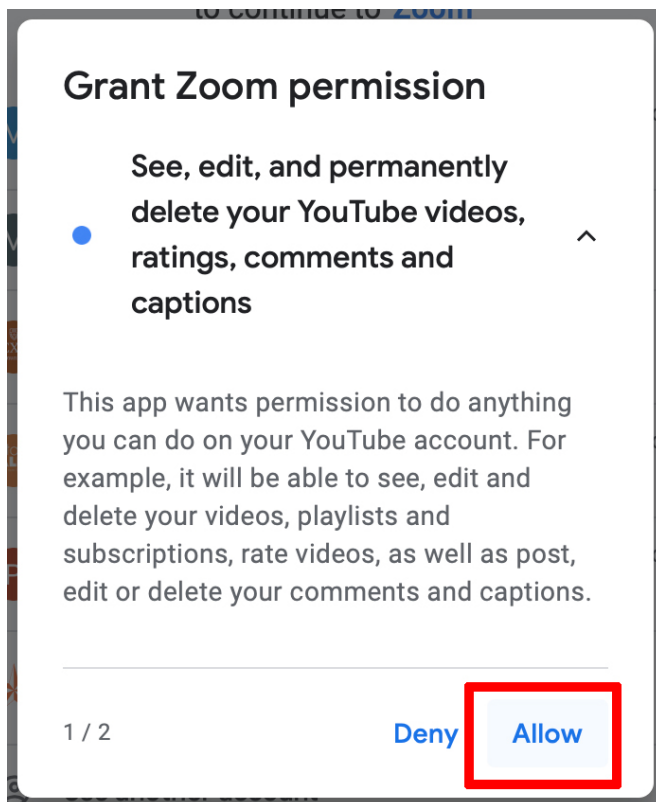
Click on **USE OTHER ACCOUNT**

Click **ALLOW** to both of these screens.



You are now ready to set up the Zoom stream.

Enter a title for Zoom meeting that will appear on YouTube. Choose if you want the

stream to be PUBLIC, UNLISTED, or PRIVATE.

Then Click **GO LIVE**
